



Since 1997, more than 2.5 million students across North America and in 32 other countries have participated in the Student Signatures in Space® program that provides students the opportunity to send their digitized signatures into space on a NASA shuttle mission.

The signed posters will be collected, digitally photographed and launched on an upcoming NASA space shuttle mission. After the flight returns, the original posters will be returned for display, along with a flight certificate and a photograph of the space shuttle crew that carried their signatures.

The Student Signatures in Space® program is jointly sponsored by NASA and Lockheed Martin Corporation, and there is no cost to participate.
