### Description of Student Assistant Program

The TechFest was first presented in 2003 for the purpose of providing opportunities to grade school and high school students to experience a wide variety of professions through hands-on exhibits prepared and presented by engineers, scientists and individuals working in various fields of technology. This event is aimed at 1) generating interest in careers in science, math, engineering and technology and 2) to help students to identify the careers areas that are most interesting to them and the areas of study needed through interaction with the exhibits and exhibitors. More than 2000 students attended the TechFest events in 2004 and 2005 (all events were free and will continue so). This year we are inviting junior and senior high school students on science and math tracks, and engineering and science students in local colleges and universities to assist the exhibitors over the two-day event (dates and times are below). This will allow the professionals more time to interact with visiting students and parents and give them time for lunch, breaks, etc. Effort will be made, but not guaranteed, to match the interests of the student applicant with a corresponding exhibit. The arrangements of training and time will be made between the student and the exhibitor.
